About our school

The AIS Vincerola Montessori School was opened on the Aachen campus in the 2020/21 school year. The educational concept enables parents to optimally balance family and career, since they are provided with reliable and advanced educational and childcare services. In language immersion children from all over the world learn German and English effortlessly in a familiar, carefully prepared environment.

The class at the new school is mixed age and taught by a team of teachers working in pairs. The welcoming classroom is equipped with Montessori independent work and supplementary materials. In addition to independent Montessori work the school also focuses on discovery and explorative learning in combination with cosmic education. As a state-recognised alternative school, the guidelines and curricula of the state of North Rhine-Westphalia apply.

The school is open from 07:30. Classes start between 08:00 and 08:15 am. After lunch and supervised homework there is an opportunity for free play, rest and relaxation and to take part in clubs, in which a variety of sporting, creative and cultural activities are offered until 16:45pm. Care ends at 17:30/18:00.

- a part-time/full-time position (teachers who are already civil servants can apply for a leave of absence of 4 years, the creation of a permanent position is possible)
- a fully equipped classroom with Montessori materials and new media
- small groups and a friendly, open working atmosphere

- A knowledge of Montessori educational theory, a Montessori diploma or willingness to obtain the relevant qualification in the near future
- Experience in teaching mixed-age, heterogeneous learning groups
- An individual teaching approach based on learning level analysis and documentation
- Interdisciplinary teaching
- Appreciative treatment of children and provision of individual support
- Education for independent learning and willingness to take responsibility
- Instruction in democratic processes and conflict resolution strategies in the class council
- Clearly structured classroom management and a binding system of rules
- Dialogue and consultation on children's development with colleagues and parents
- Care of the prepared environment
- Professional skills and willingness to engage in further training
- Self-analytical and critical faculties
- Up-to-date media skills
- Constructive cooperation with team partners and the school authorities.
